Where?

On a hill top in the middle of the capital, Kampala, there is a BB centre. From the balcony you can look down on the vibrant city. A short distance away is Lake Victoria, the largest lake in Africa and the Nile, the longest river in the world. We invite you to join us for this workshop in the middle of Uganda right in the heart of Africa.

Why?

Global Fellowship wants to provide a learning-lab. for young leaders with cross-cultural activities. In our globalized world there is a great need for interaction. It is a way you develop, improve your leadership and advance your organisation. This is a fantastic chance to learn about other cultures, inspire each other with new ideas, get a better understanding of other nations, and to make new friends across the world. We have called the workshop "Telling our stories", because story-telling is a learning-process, in which both the listener and the storyteller participate. Therefore we ask each person attending, to bring your own story (or work it out together with the other participant from your country). The story may include your reflection of part or all of what it means to be a young leader of a Christian organisation in modern society.

How?

Apply to your own organisation which will select and approve candidates forwarding their details to Global Fellowship.

What?

Bring your story, share other's stories, and take a new story back to your organisation

- ◆ Opening ceremony with traditional drums, band, GF-song
- ◆ Service in the Namirembe Cathedral
- ◆ Tell your story (in drama, music, film or ...)
- ◆ Theology, Psychology, Anthropology
- ◆ Group sessions on social issues
- ◆ Excursions: Swimming in the Nile or a picnic at the waterfalls
- ◆ Worship
- ◆ Fun and social games
- ◆ Barbeque
- ◆ Teambuilding



Accommodation

"Namirembe Resource Centre - Narec" with rooms, dining hall, assemble hall. The rooms have 4 beds with shared showers and toilet facilities.



Price

100 US\$ per participant. Participants arrange their own visa, insurance and vaccinations etc. and are responsible for their own transport to and from Kampala (by road) or Entebbe International Airport (by air) On request some assistance may be available from GF.

This registration fee of 100\$ much be paid before 1st of April to Global Fellowship via your national organisation.

There can only be 2 participants, aged 18 - 30 from each member organisation.

Afterwards

BB Uganda is willing to help you if your would like to extend your stay, at your own expense. You are advised to find out how much this will cost before making any arrangements as it could be very expensive.
