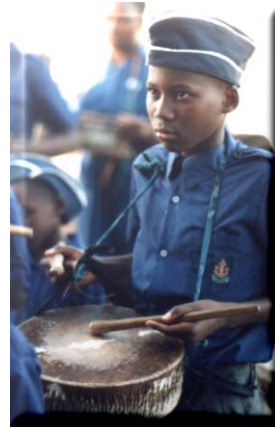
We also need people who will commit to regularly pray for our members and their ministry. Updates of news and concerns are regularly posted on the website for this purpose.
