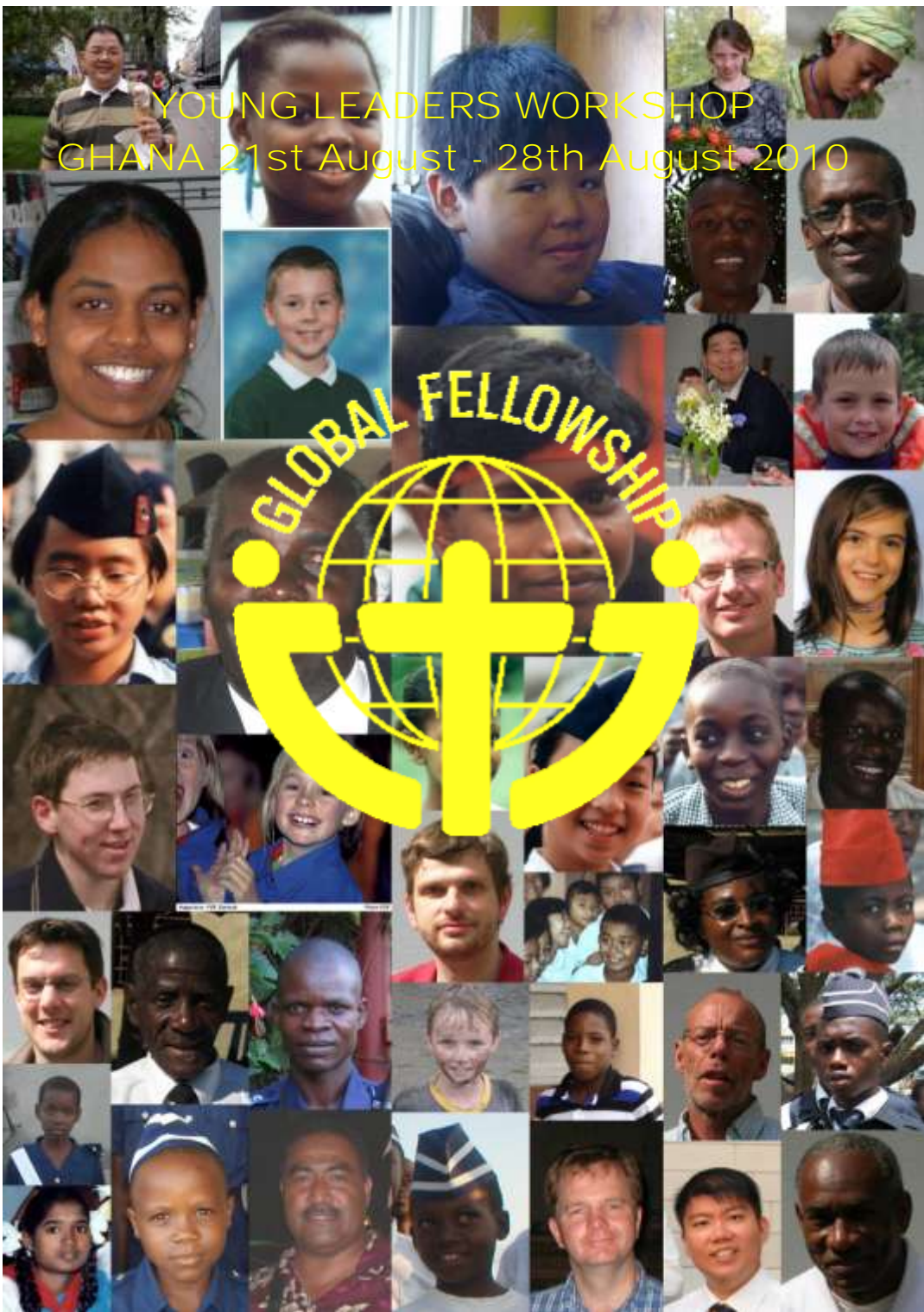

Facing the World ...

With this theme Global Fellowship invites young leaders to an international training course with leadership development in focus.

Venue

The course will take place in Ghana –north of the Capital Accra at *Shai Hills Resort* about 1 hour from the airport. The resort has a beautiful garden where we shall take our meals and from where you can see the mountains in the background, and strange formations of rocks. Nearby is a national game park, so while you are eating monkeys may pay you a visit.



Leadership development

Global Fellowship wants to provide a learning “lab” for young leaders with cross-cultural activities. In our globalized world there is a big need for interaction. It is a way of developing yourself, improving your leadership and bringing your organizations forward. This is a fantastic chance to learn about other cultures, to inspire each others with new ideas, to get a better understanding of our societies, and to meet new friends across the world. **We have called the workshop “Faces of the world – facing the world”. The participants will cover the first line: “Faces of the world”, and therefore we challenge you on this: please bring something, which can tell more about you: a video clip, a story, a song, or ...** The participants will be sent more information about this, when we know who is coming.

Accommodation

Shai Hills Resort. The rooms are with 2 beds, showers and toilet facilities.



Price

100 US \$ per participant. Each participant has to arrange their own visa, insurance and medical vaccinations etc. Please note that yellow fever vaccination is compulsory. Each participant has to arrange their own transport to and from Accra Airport Ghana. Assistance may be available from GF on request.

The registration fee of 100 US \$ must be paid by yourself or your organisation when the course starts.

Programme:

- Opening Service
- Opening ceremony with traditional drums, band etc.
- Faces of the world – images – stories – video clips etc.
- Theology – Psychology – Anthropology
- Group-sessions on social issues
- Excursions–Akosombo Dam, wild Game Park–beach-walking
maybe swimming
- Worship
- Fun and social games
- Teambuilding

The workshop is one week long, but you will be asked to prepare something in advance. GF also expect that you will carry some useful input back to your organization. As soon as we have all the names of the course participants we shall communicate directly to you about this and other things.

The training course is open to 2 young leaders from each member organisation aged 18-30
